Furthermore, attached also the FY 2019 GAD Accomplishment Report (AR) for your records and reference




II. RESOLUTION APPROVING THE GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT (GAD) PLANS AND BUDGET FOR FY 2019 AMOUNTING TO SEVEN MILLION PESOS ONLY (PHP 7,000,000.00).


WHEREAS, in compliance to Republic Act No. 9710, otherwise known as the Magna Carta of Women (MCW), the Women in Development and Nation Building (RA 7192), EO 273 operationalizes the Philippine Plan for Gender-Responsive Development (PPGD). Directing all national and local government agencies to incorporate and reflect GAD concerns in the annual budget proposals, works and financial plan of all government agencies, including local government units;

WHEREAS, the GAD Budget policy authorizes the government agencies, offices, bureaus, state universities and colleges, government owned and controlled corporations and LGU to uilize at least five percent (5%) of their annual budget for Gender and Development (GAD) related activities;

WHEREAS, the following are the legal bases for which the policy authorized:

- 1. Philippine Plan for Gender Responsive Development (PPGD), 1995-2015 expressed public financing commitment for identified specific goals, services and activities for women:
- 2. Joint Circular 99-4 and 2001- are GAD administrative guidelines issued by the National Economic Development Authority (NEDA), the Department of Budget and





Management (DBM), and the NCRFW ( now Philippine Commission on Women or PCW);

3. Section 27 of RA 8760 or the 1999 General Appropriations Act; and Joint MC 2011-03 provides for integrating GAD in the local planning and Budgeting system;

WHEREAS, the Women in Development and Nation Building Act (RA 7192) mandates that all government agencies, including local government units should formulate a GAD Plan designed to empower women and address gender issues;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to approve the Gender and Development Plans and Budgets for FY 2019 amounting to Seven Million Pesos only (PhP 7,000,000.00)

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT, a copy of this resolution will be submitted to the Local Water Utilities Administration (LWUA) for endorsement to Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) together with the hard copy of GAD Plans and Budgets for FY 2019 in excel format.
